ANNUAL REPORT (30 August 2022 to 28 August 2023)

Presented by Dr. Bidyut Samanta, Principal in the 75th Foundation Day Celebration Ceremony of Kharagpur College.

It is a matter of great joy and pride for all of us that Kharagpur College, after completing 74 years of its glorious journey, entered 75th year of its foundation this 29th day of August 2023. On this auspicious occasion, we have arranged a programme to commemorate this unforgettable event with all our honourable guests, well wishers, faculties, non-teaching staff and students with fervour and solemnity. It is of great pleasure to me to extend a very warm and hearty welcome on behalf of the college to all those present in this auspicious function. I solemnly remember with high regards, Prof. H. B. Sarkar, the Founder Principal of this college, and, also, all other honourable persons, who contributed selflessly towards development of this institution in different capacities at different times. We are grateful to Prof.(Dr.) Tapan Kumar Pal, WBSCHER nominee of the Governing Body of our college, an Educationalist and Social Worker to preside over the programme.

We are sincerely thankful to Prof. Anjan Chaki, Honourable President of the Governing Body of this college for his relentless effort to provide effective leadership towards achieving phenomenal progress in every aspect of the college. Thanks are due to all other members of the Governing Body for their valuable guidance and support in all matters. I express my indebtedness to our students, faculties and non-teaching staff whose cooperation and active participation, round the year, in maintaining normal schedule and also in achieving progress are praiseworthy. We also express our deep gratitude to Vidyasagar University, UGC and Govt. of West Bengal.

Now, I take opportunity to place before you the round-up events occurred during the last one year since we celebrated our 74th year of the establishment of the college.

It is my great pleasure to mention that our College has been received an amount of Rupees Thirty Lacs only under RUSA 2.0 infrastructural grant by the Rastriya Uchhatar Siksha Avijan (RUSA) for new construction, renovation and procurement of equipment, books, computer and printers. New equipment, computers, printers, books have been procured from this grant.

Construction of a new building named “Vivekananda Bhavana” and vertical extension of two classroom buildings have been completed with the financial support of RUSA 2.0 grant.

Also; Construction of first floor of the existing central Library building is completed with the financial support of Government of West Bengal.

During this period, our colleagues Prof. Ranajit Biswas, Associate Professor, Deptt of Bengali and Prof. Udit Bhattacharya, Associate Professor, Dept of History retired from their

service. We express our regards to him and solemnly remember his invaluable contribution to academic and cultural affairs of this institution.

During this period, our colleagues Sri Rabindranath Chakraborty, skilled Laboratory attendant of Department of Chemistry retired from his service. We express our gratitude and sincere regards to all of them for their invaluable services rendered to this institution.

During this period, following activities have been undertaken by the different section of the college.

- (i) As per recommendation of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of this college, all the departments conducted students seminar and semester wise mentoring and counselling of the students. Parent-teachers meetings were also conducted in all departments in this academic session. Mentor allotment of 1st semester students was done.
- i) 08 smart classrooms are equipped with modern interactive flat touch panels.
- ii) 18 certificate courses conducted by the different departments.
- iii) Student feedback on teacher analysed and send to the teachers for quality improvements and teachers feedback on syllabus sent to the University.
- iv) 18 new MoUs initiated and seven existing MoUs have been renewed.
- v) Remedial books stock shifted to the central library.
- vi) Internet bandwidth enhanced to increase the browsing speed in the campus.
- vii) Teaching plan for even semesters (2nd, 4th& 6th) prepared by the all the faculties and departmental teaching plan has been uploaded in the college webpage
- viii) Around 45 number of desktop purchased for students use in the Library and computer laboratory.
- ix) Our faculties published 44 number of research work in the peer reviewed journal and 17 number of books/chapter in edited volume in the national level publisher.
- x) Twelve numbers of national/ State level seminar/ workshop conducted by the different department.
- xi) The institutional environment and energy initiatives are confirmed through Energy, Environment and Green Audit certificate by the Greenvio Solutions, Palghar District, Maharashtra- 401208. Also, Sustainability index certificate has been

provided by the MGNCRE, Govt of India in the areas of Sanitation, Hygiene, Waste Management, Water Management, Energy Management and Greenery Management.

xii) Professional development program on “The use of SMART Boards for Smarter Teaching- Learning Process organized by the IQAC on 27.05.2023.

xiii) Two days training cum orientation program for non-teaching laboratory staff was conducted by the Lab based departments.

xiv) Online Feedback has been taken from all the stakeholders i.e. Students’, teachers, parents and Alumni. These feedbacks were discussed in the IQAC meeting and communicated to the individual teachers by the Principal for quality improvement of teaching learning process.

xv) AQAR 2021-22 prepared and submitted to the NAAC portal on 04.04.2023 and it was accepted on 24.04.2023.

xvi) Preparation of AQAR 2022-23 is going on.

Now, I would like to address that 101 number of teaching and 13 number of non-teaching staff participated in Faculty development Programmes (FDP), Management Development Programmes (MDPs) professional development /administrative training programs.
