WHEREAS

- C) IIMS is a MBA College approved by AICTE, Govt. of India and affiliated to MAKAUT. IIMS conducting 2-years Fulltime MBA Programme.



- D) The Parties are desirous of entering this Memorandum of Understanding to declare their respective intentions and to establish a "Academic Partnership" for conducting Training Programme, Education, Research
- E) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

NOW THIS MOU WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS:

OBJECTIVE

The Parties, subject to the terms of this Memorandum of Understanding and the laws, rules, regulations and national policies from time to time in force in each party's country, shall endeavour to strengthen, promote and develop Education, Tranning, Research and Projects cooperation between the Parties on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

AREAS OF COOPERATION

- Both parties agree to encourage the following activities, in particular, to promote 2.1 Seminar, Academic, Research, Training Programme cooperation in the following areas:
 - Institutional exchanges between faculty and staff from each partner institution; a)
 - Acceptance of students of each partner institution for periods of study and/or b) research;
 - Organization of symposia, conferences, courses, Training, Workshop and meetings c) on research issues;
 - exchange of information pertaining to developments in teaching, student d) development and research institutions;



- e) cooperation in any other areas as agreed to by the Parties from time to time; and
- 2.2 The Both the organisations will be responsible for conducting the different academic programmes till the end of the aforesaid programmes in scheduled time as decided time to time in a proper manner.
- 2.3 Both the organizations will provide the detailed programme structure along with design, content, title of the programmes, number of speakers as per the requirement before the commencement of the scheduled programmes.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

3.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other.

EFFECT OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding serves only as a record of the Parties' intentions and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create, obligations under domestic or international law and shall not give rise to any legal process and shall not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied.

ENTRY INTO EFFECT AND DURATION

- 6.1 This Memorandum of Understanding shall become effective as of the date of signatures of both parties or if the dates vary, the date of the later signature.
- 6.2 This Memorandum of Understanding shall remain in effect for a period of FIVE (5) years.
- 6.3 This Memorandum of Understanding may be extended for such further period as may be agreed in writing by both parties.

REVISION, VARIATION AND AMENDMENT

- 7.1 Either party may request in writing a revision, variation or amendment of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 7.2 Any such revision, variation or amendment agreed to by the Parties shall be in writing and shall form part of this Memorandum of Understanding.
- 7.3 Such revision, variation or amendment shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties.
- 7.4 Any revision, variation or amendment shall not prejudice the implementation of any project, activity or co-operation arising from or based on this Memorandum of Understanding before or up to the date of such revision, variation or amendment.

TERMINATION

This Memorandum of Understanding may be terminated by either party with a minimum of THIRTY (30) days written notice. Activities in progress at the time of termination of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be permitted to conclude as planned unless otherwise agreed.

NOTICES

Any communication under this Memorandum of Undestanding shall be in writing in the English language and delivered by registered mail to the address or sent to the electronic mail address or facsimile number of International Institute of Management Sciences and Kharagpur College as the case may be, shown below or to such other address or electronic, mail address or facsimile number as either Party may have notified the other Party and shall, unless otherwise provided herein, be deemed to be duly given or made when delivered to the recipient at such address or electronic mail address or facsimile number which is duly acknowledged:

PROTECTION OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- (ii) solely and separately by a Party or if the research results were obtained through the sole and separate effort of the Party, then these shall be solely owned by the Party concerned.

- 11.1 Each Party shall undertake to observe the confidentiality and secrecy of documents, information and other data received from or supplied to, the other party during the period of the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding or any other agreements made pursuant to this Memorandum of Understanding.
 - 11.2 Both Parties agree that the provisions of this Article shall continue to be binding between the Parties notwithstanding the termination of this Memorandum of Understanding.

SUSPENSION

Each Party reserves the right for reasons of national security, national interest, public order or public health to suspend temporarily, either in whole or in part, the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding which suspension shall take effect immediately after notification has been given to the other Party.

SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES

Any difference or dispute between the Parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provisions of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation and/or negotiations between the parties through any third party.
