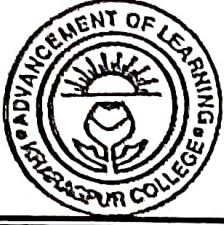

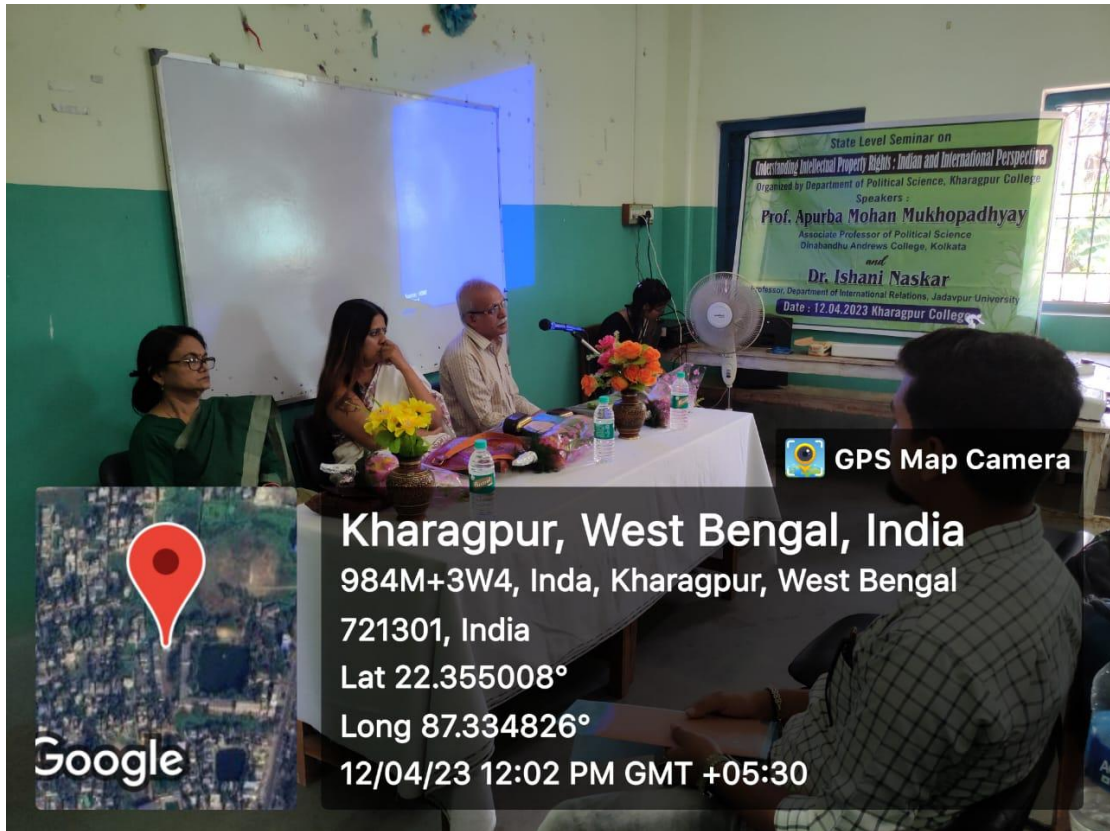

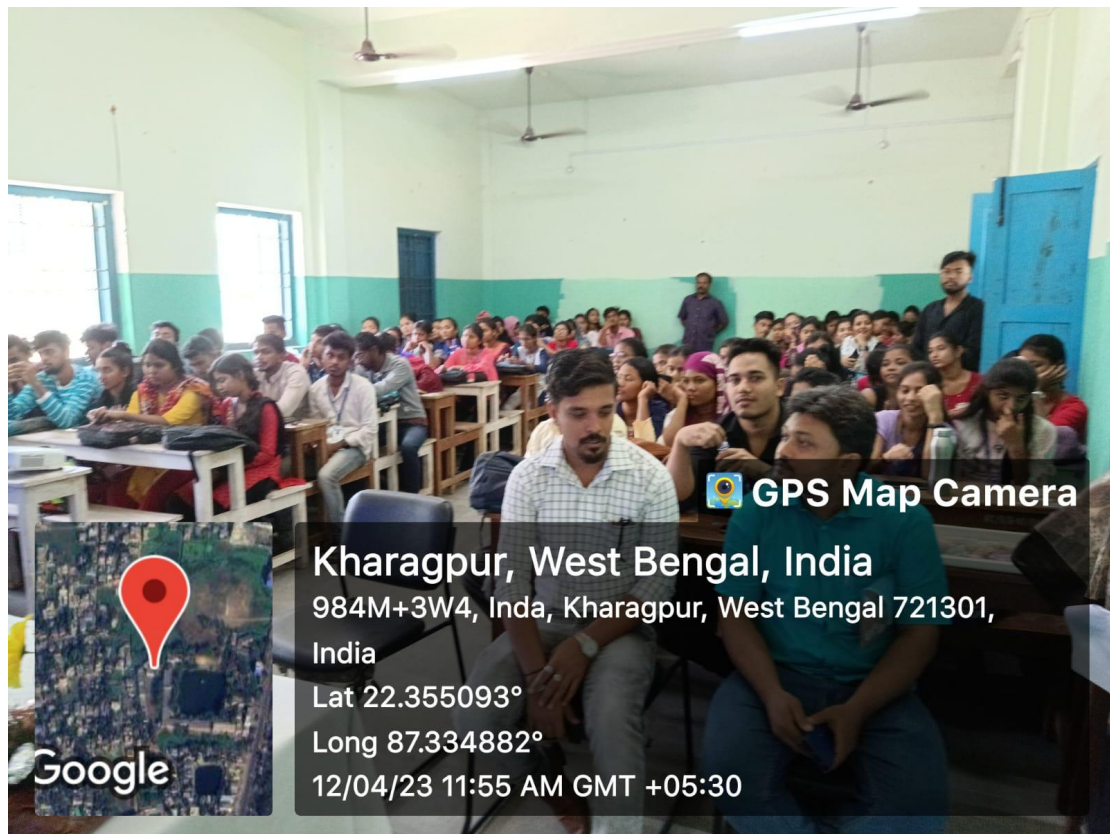

Date: 12/04/2023

The Department of Political Science, as per its meeting held on 10/03/23, organized a one day State Level Seminar on 12/04/2023 at room no VS-101 of the college. The Topic of the Seminar was Understanding ***Intellectual Property Rights: Indian and International Perspectives***. Dr. Ishani Naskar, Professor of International Relations, Jadavpur University, and Prof. Apurba Mohan Mukhopadhyay, Associate Professor of Political Science, Dinabandhu Andrews College, Kolkata, were present as the speakers and delivered two lectures on the aforesaid topic from two different perspectives. Dr. Naskar has delivered her lecture from the point of view of international perspective of Intellectual Property Rights and its importance in the era of globalization

and neo-liberal economy as well its history from GATT. On the other hand Prof. Apurba Mohan Mukhopadhyay , spoke on the very idea of IPR, its meaning, theoretical viewpoint and specially from Indian Perspective. Welcome address was given by Dr. Shukla Mondal Saha and she chaired the programme.
