

Report	At the beginning of his lecture he informed the students about language death and what is an endangered languages? He told the first and second language speakers and elaborately discussed the four major levels of language endangerment namely the vulnerable, definitely endangered, severely endangered and critically endangered with suitable illustrations. He also spoke various ways to stop language death. Along with this he provided some suggestions like create healthy environment, modify the language, documentation of their languages, dictionary, language learning materials, official and political recognition etc. There was a question - answer session where the students cleared their doubts by asking various pertinent questions relating to the topic under discussion.
