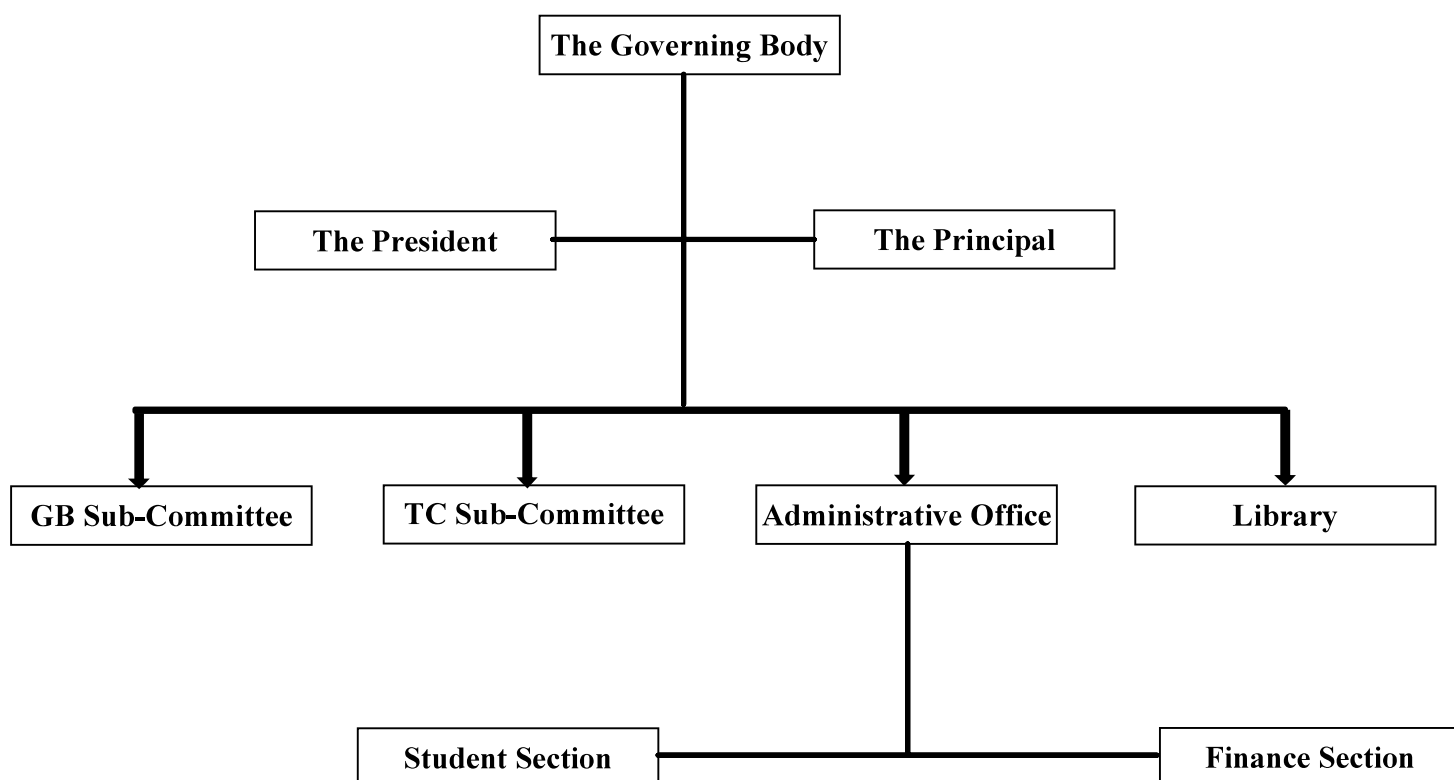

Enrollment in NCC: - The NCC Companies for both boys and girls of this college are under 25 BN NCC. Renewals of enrolment in subsequent years for NCC will be made on payment of Rs. 4/-only.

Many NCC cadets of this college holding "C" certificate have been granted commissions in the armed forces. Paramilitary forces like BSF, CRPF, CISF, ITBP, and coast guard give weightage to the NCC cadets in recruitment as Officers & other rank. NCC youth Exchange Programme: The NCC has a unique exchange programme with youth organization of many foreign countries like United Kingdom, Canada, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives, Nepal, Singapore, Sri Lanka and Trinidad and Tobago etc selected cadets have the opportunity to travel abroad through this programme.

Students' Grievance Redressal Cell of the college is constituted to receive, analyse and redress the **genuine grievances** of the students. As per UGC Guidelines the "grievances" include the following complaints of the aggrieved students, namely:

(i) making admission contrary to merit determined in accordance with the declared admission policy of the institute;

(ii) irregularity in the admission process adopted by the institute;

(iii) refusing admission in accordance with the declared admission policy of the institute;

(iv) non publication of prospectus, as specified;

(v) publishing any information in the prospectus, which is false or misleading, and not based on facts;

(vi) withhold or refuse to return any document in the form of certificates of degree, diploma or any other award or other document deposited with it by a person for the purpose of seeking admission in such institution, with a view to induce or compel such person to pay any fee or fees in respect of any course or program of study which such person does not intend to pursue;

(vii) demand of money in excess of that specified in the declared admission policy or approved by the competent authority to be charged by such institution;

(viii) breach of the policy for reservation in admission as may be applicable;

(ix) complaints, of alleged discrimination of students, from the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Women, Minority or Disabled categories;

(x) non payment or delay in payment of scholarships to any student that such institution is committed, under the conditions imposed by University Grants Commission, or by any other authority;

(xi) delay in conduct of examinations or declaration of results beyond that specified in the academic calendar;

(xii) on provision of student amenities as may have been promised or required to be provided by the institution;

(xiii) denial of quality education as promised at the time of admission or required to be provided;

(xiv) non transparent or unfair evaluation practices;

(xv) harassment and victimisation of students, including sexual harassment;

The **grievances may be submitted by the aggrieved student himself or his parents in writing** to any member of the Cell and a received copy of the application may be preserved by the student. The aggrieved student can also submit his grievance in writing **through email to the convener** of the cell. The application must contain Name, Roll Number, Class, Section (Day/Morning/Evening), Phone Number and mail id (if any) of the applicant.
