# Revised Admission Notification for PG Courses in Bengali, English and History for the academic session 2024-2025

Date: 30.08.2024

Applications are invited for admission to the Post-graduate Programmes (M.A. in **Bengali, English & History**) for the academic session 2024-2025. Duly filled in applications are required to be submitted through the online admission portal of Kharagpur College (<a href="www.kharagpurcollege.in">www.kharagpurcollege.in</a>) / (<a href="www.kharagpurcollege.ac.in">www.kharagpurcollege.ac.in</a>)

Those who had already submitted their application form and paid the Fees for Common Entrance Test (CET) during 1<sup>st</sup> phase of application (10-08-2024 to 20-08-2024), NEED NOT APPLY AGAIN. However, they can modify/upload details (e.g. Final Semester Marks)

#### **Application Procedure:**

- ➤ The applicants will fill in the Application Form through online portal only.
- The applicants have to fill in the form with the personal details and academic details and have to upload the scanned copies of all marksheets, photo and signature. The selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit in the **Common Entrance Test (CET)** conducted by the authority of Kharagpur College. The fees (non-refundable) for the Common Entrance Test of **Rs.400.00** are to be paid online through the admission portal during the submission of Application Form.
- Programmes with their percentage (%) of marks. In case of semester system, applicants have to fill in the equivalent percentage of marks corresponding to CGPA (Cumulative Grade Point Average) obtained as per Rule of their home University/institutions. In case of Annual system, the percentage (%) of marks (aggregate of Part-I, II & III) has to be filled up. Applicants who will appear, are appearing or have appeared at their final semester examination and are awaiting the publication of their result, need not fill-up the data under Semester VI option. Applicants have to upload the documents showing conversion rule of the University/Institution (on the Reverse side of the Marksheets, if the conversion rule for CGPA to the equivalent percentage is mentioned). The applicants have to produce all the original marksheets. Identity proof at the time of verification.

## **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO PG COURSES**

1. Only students who have passed out in the year **2022** and **2023** and the students who have passed out or appeared in the year **2024** (provided marksheets showing proof of passing are shown at the time of verification) are eligible for admission to the Post-graduate Programmes for the academic session 2024- 2025.

Bengali, English & History	Honours in the concerned subject

#### SELECTION AND ADMISSION PROCESS

- 1. Selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit in the Common Entrance Test (CET)
- 2. Reservation Policy will be considered as per the latest order of the Govt. of West Bengal.

#### 3. For the students of Vidyasagar University

The reservation of seats for the students of Vidyasagar University and / or autonomous college(s) affiliated to Vidyasagar University, will be as per the latest order of the Govt. of West Bengal

5% seats in each category will be reserved for differently-abled applicants. Merit list will be prepared on the basis of percentage of disability. In case of non-availability of differently-able candidates, the seat(s) reserved for differently-able applicants of the particular category will be converted to the original category only.

### 4. For the students of other Universities:

The reservation of seats for the students of other Universities will be as per the latest order of the Govt. of West Bengal.

Eligibility criteria for other university students:

Honours in the concerned subject

The minimum marks required for admission is as follows:

- (a) 45% marks in Honours (for unreserved candidates)
- (b) 40% marks in Honours (for reserved/differently-abled applicants)
- 5. Questions of CET will be MCQ Pattern. The total No. of questions will be 50. The duration of CET will be one hour.
- 6. Two (02) marks will be awarded for each correct answer. In case of incorrect answer (0.5) half-mark will be deducted.
- 7. Questions will be set in English for all subjects except Bengali.
- 8. Online provisional admission will be done through the college admission portal.
- 9. The verification of testimonials and other documents for provisionally admitted students will be done before the commencement of classes by the office.
